# Pastor's Letter

May 4/5

## It's For Your Own Good

Dear parish family,

Childhood has certain key words and phrases often used by adults to signal the telling of something important. Phrases like "Don't make me come down there!" or "If I have to tell you one more time!" let us know that it was time for action. Among all the phrases heard in childhood was the most feared: "It's for your own good." It meant that the punishment would be deserved, the medicine would be bitter, the lesson would be hard.

In John's gospel Jesus tells his disciples: "It is for your own good that I go." He is talking not only about his ascension to heaven but also about the sending of the Spirit. Jesus is telling his disciples that he wants them to be his ministers, his life, and his presence in the world. He wants them to do his work. But they will not do so as long as Jesus is with them. Unless he withdraws from them and trusts them to continue the mission, they will be content to let Jesus serve the needs of all. As Jesus steps back the disciples begin to recognize that they have been empowered. They begin to do for others what Jesus did. In this the Holy Spirit is received and the church is born.

It is interesting that Jesus seemed to know that his departure would be traumatic for his disciples. He knew that the ministry entrusted to them would be awesome and that they would be reluctant to take up his ministry. The promise of the Spirit is the great assurance that although the work of the gospel will be their own, they will not be alone.

At his inauguration in 1961 President John F. Kennedy concluded his address asking God's blessing and presence because "here on this earth God's work must truly be our own." In a very eloquent phrase he captured what every saint already knew: we are the voice, the hands, the body of Christ in the world.

It is for our own good that we have been given this ministry. Even more than that! It is for the good of the church, the good of our country, the good of our Earth that we spread this good news. The sending of the Spirit is no bitter medicine or hard lesson. It is an invitation to be part of what God is doing in our world.
