# Sacred Hearts And the Year of Mercy

Dear Parish Family,

Pope Francis has declared the year to come, beginning on December 8, the feast of the Immaculate Conception, to be a Holy Year of Mercy. Here on Long Island, Bishop Murphy has designated four churches to be places of special celebration of this jubilee year: the Cathedral of St. Agnes in Rockville Centre, the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception in Huntington, the Shrine of Our Lady of the Isle in Eastport, and us—the Basilica Parish of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. What does this mean for us?


- Part of the Holy Year is the opening of a door as a symbolic gesture of welcome to all those who seek the blessings of this special time. One of our bishops will be present here on the weekend of December 12/13 to open our main doors with the same words of welcome and blessing used by Pope Francis at St. Peter's in Vatican City.
- Each of the churches chosen as a center will have a special day during the week to welcome pilgrims who come there seeking the grace and blessings of the Holy Year. If you would like to help us with hospitality, prayer, tours of our church, etc., please let me know you are willing to help.
- We will be extending our hours of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. I will be asking those of you who understand the importance of this prayer to help us by pledging a time of prayer.
- We plan to have a number of special events for young people and families so they can celebrate this year in their own special way. Again, I am happy to receive your ideas and willingness to help.
- We are now planning a special mission for this Lent: Mission of Mercy to focus on the gospel call to live mercy in our forgiveness and in our hospitality to the stranger and immigrant as we become the face of mercy to others.
- We are hosting a Holy Year pilgrimage to Italy. There are still places available on this trip.
- And hopefully many other times of celebration and hospitality.

I am proud that our community has been chosen to be a place of welcome and celebration for this special year. I hope you will join me in helping to reveal the kindness and mercy of God.
