

# Pastor's Letter

January 9/10, 2016

## In Nomine Domini Progress

Dear Parish Family,

The last few months have been full of planning meetings so that our In Nomine Domini renovations can be completed by the beginning of June. You will now begin to see a high level of activity which will bring our projects to reality. Here is how it will happen:

Just this past week the foundation for our vestibule restrooms was poured. You can see this work on the east side of the church outside the vestibule door. The framing of this space will shortly be completed and our restrooms should be working by the middle of Lent.

Electrical work for the new heating and air conditioning was completed in December. From a power point of view we are all hooked up and ready to go. We now have all required permits for our geothermal wells and so with a little weather luck, the drilling and plumbing will be completed before Lent begins. A little weather luck here will be a big help!

Over the next few weeks some preparatory work will be done in the boiler room. Our new heating system will include under floor radiators in the center of the church. These will be installed during the month of February. They will not be operational until next winter but everyone in the church will soon be toasty warm.

The main events begin the day after Easter. On that Monday, March 28, all the pews will be removed for refinishing. Meanwhile, the new heating / cooling units will be installed and old radiators removed. Work inside the church will take about two weeks. For the two weeks after Easter, daily Mass will be held in the rectory chapel and Sunday Mass in the school auditorium.

When that work is completed we will be back in church, temperature permitting, since the mechanical side of the new system will take another couple of weeks to complete. We expect to be back in church with new pews and carpeting by the first week of May. As soon as the system and controls are complete, our new heating / cooling will be operational.

Over the summer some final cosmetic work will be completed. The new heating / cooling units will have wood finish to make them blend into our beautiful church woodwork.

Thanks so much for supporting this project. I will continue to keep you informed as we move along.



Sin el testimonio del perdón, sin embargo, queda solo una vida infecunda y estéril, como si se viviese en un desierto desolado. Ha llegado de nuevo para la Iglesia el tiempo de encargarse del anuncio alegre del perdón. Es el tiempo de retornar a lo esencial para hacernos cargo de las debilidades y dificultades de nuestros hermanos. 
