Pastor's Letter

March 12/13, 2016

Catholic Ministries Appeal

Dear Parish Family,

Generosity has the power to change someone's life. We see this every week here in our parish. When people become aware of a person in need, especially parishioners here at Sacred Hearts, they respond generously and compassionately.

I write today to encourage your generous participation in the Catholic Ministries Appeal. Last year over 250 Sacred Heart parishioners participated in the appeal and we raised over \$40,000 for the ministries of our diocese. This year our appeal is especially important because we have just begun two wonderful outreach ministries. We now have a youth ministry and a parish social ministry. Both of these ministries rely on the resources of our diocese, particularly Catholic Charities and Diocesan Youth Services. Because of this partnership I would be most grateful if you could help us to reach our goal of \$57,000.

The Catholic Ministries Appeal also supports ministries such as the Bishop Ryan Village in neighboring Hampton Bays. In this residence, many disabled and elderly Long Islanders find welcome and help. The appeal also supports the religious life of young people attending our state universities. Your generosity brings them the spiritual life of Mass through the work of Catholic campus ministers. Perhaps most importantly, the appeal funds the education of men following the call to priesthood and diaconate.

Yes, you can make a tremendous difference in someone's life! Please take a moment to prayerfully consider beginning, renewing or even increasing your support. Your gift, of course, is a personal decision and I only ask that you be guided by your own circumstances and by the needs of our Catholic community here on Long Island.

There is an incentive for us as well. While 250 participants is a wonderful response, it is still only one in six SHJM families. Every new participant will be a huge step toward our goal.




