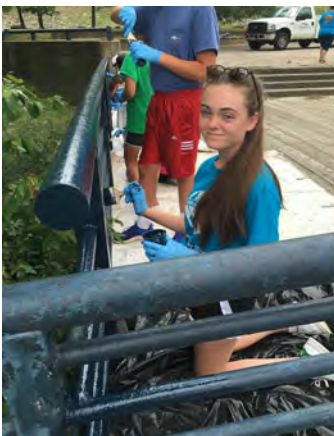


Fall Youth Group Service Opportunities

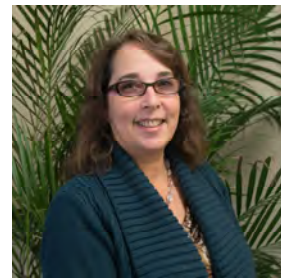

Catholic Daughters of America

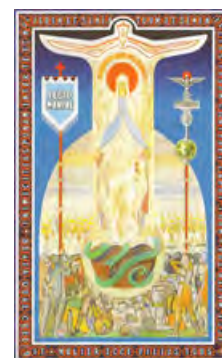
Ladies, 18 years of age or older, are invited to consider joining Catholic Daughters of the Americas. We hope to have enough interest to officially start a new court in this parish.

Reflections On the
Gospel
August 14, 2016

Not an easy message Jesus leaves us with this Sunday. None of Sunday's readings is easy. All say similar things: God's message may not always be what we want to hear, and those who profess it may actually put their lives in danger. Certainly, Jesus did, as did the prophets and martyrs. But that is what we are called to do—to witness to God's message of love where there is hate, of mercy where there is vindictiveness, of generosity where there is selfishness, of peace where there is conflict. We need to be the fire that Jesus desired, the fire that the Holy Spirit brings. Let it burst forth in your passion for refugees, trafficked persons, victims of war and domestic violence, the sick and disabled, children and the elderly, the hungry and homeless, the unemployed and underemployed, for anyone and everyone who is denied justice and in need of compassion. "Keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus," let's not worry about how unpopular his way may be; let's draw courage from him and "run the race that lies before us."
