Pastor's Letter

As Summer Begins — Lives to Remember

May 27/28

Dear Parish Family,

Just last Saturday our Southampton community celebrated the passing of a young man, Sam Price, who passed away May 17th after a battle with cancer. Sam was a member of our Southampton Fire Department and Southampton Village Volunteer Ambulance. Actually, Sam was part of just about everything that was happening in our village. He was proud and patriotic, compassionate and service minded, with a joyful and life-giving spirit. At the age of twenty-five he had already made a significant impact on the lives of many.

Sam belonged to St. John's Episcopal Church and his memorial service brought together people of every faith and background. Prayers were said by his pastor, Fr. Patrick Edwards, by lifelong family friend, Pastor Richard King, and by me. People lined up for hours at his wake to pay their respects. Among them were several hundred firefighters, police, and rescue workers from our village and twenty-six neighboring communities. They filled St. Andrew's Dune Church, walked in procession to a final farewell at the Windmill Lane Firehouse, and bore powerful tribute to the goodness of Sam's life.

People like Sam are what Jesus called "the salt of the earth and light of the world." And it is at this time, at the very beginning of summer on Memorial Day, that we come together to honor the lives that bring such goodness to our world. Along with people like Sam we remember those men and women who gave their lives to safeguard the dignity and freedom of others.





Reflections On the Gospel

May 28, 2017

This Sunday finds us between Jesus's earthly departure (the Ascension) and the arrival of the Holy Spirit (Pentecost). It is an in-between time, what could be a sad and lonely time, even a scary time. What do the Apostles and disciples do with this time? The first reading tells us they go to the upper room where they were staying—together—and they pray. They are in community, a community of faith and support for one another. Their handling of this in-between time can be a lesson for us, for we, too, have experienced such times when we have had to say good-bye to someone we love. We feel sad and lonely, perhaps scared. When that happens, we need to be there for one another, and we need to pray. The Spirit *will* come, and we will be all the stronger because of our mutual support. Filled with the Holy Spirit, we will mature into our own expression of the life and love of the One who has left us.


