# Pastor's Letter

June 3/4

## Who is in Charge Here?

Dear Parish Family,

From time to time people bring me bulletins from parishes they visit on trips or vacations. One I received recently caught my eye. The bulletin had, as most do, a list of priests and ministers in the parish. In this bulletin the pastor listed himself among the staff and on the top line next to pastor he put: Jesus Christ!

I am sure that caught many an eye and probably got people thinking about their parish life. Jesus is the pastor, everyone else is staff – or to use a more biblical expression, Jesus is the master and all others are the servants. I, too, thought about this interesting and unique bulletin but I thought, with all due respect, that my brother pastor had made a mistake. He should have said that the Holy Spirit is the pastor.

In his book on the Holy Spirit, "The Go Between God," John Taylor begins with these words: "The chief actor in the historic mission of the Christian church is the Holy Spirit. He is the director of the whole enterprise. This mission consists in the things that he is doing in the world. In a special way it consists in the light that he is focusing upon Jesus Christ."

Taylor is here touching on something very fundamental and important. The Holy Spirit is the director of the church and the Holy Spirit works in us despite our weakness, sinfulness, and humanness. Some have said that the surest sign that the Holy Spirit is with the church is that the church has survived two thousand years of the humanity of popes, priests, ministers, pastors, and people who have been its body.

In the Acts of the Apostles, a group of new Christians ask St. Paul how they might receive the Holy Spirit. Paul prays for them and they become inspired Christians. 'Inspired' means literally – *breathed into*. They cannot get this spirit on their own. They have to ask and hope for God to breath the spirit into them.





For the elderly on Long Island, **Meals-on-Wheels** is a lifesaver. Every weekday, the program delivers hot, nutritious meals to seniors who are homebound in Nassau and Suffolk counties. Meals-on-Wheels case managers can also assist these clients in accessing other services they might need.

*“I knew something was wrong as soon as I saw him,”* explains Steve, a driver for Catholic Charities’ Meals-on-Wheels. Steve had been delivering meals to Ed for several years and upon arriving that fateful day, immediately observed that he seemed disoriented.

Steve knew Ed was diabetic, so he checked his blood sugar and saw that it was low. He poured him some orange juice but sensed there was something more serious going on. *“I kept asking him to let me call 911 but he resisted. I couldn’t accept that so I just casually stuck around, making my case. He finally admitted that he didn’t have anyone to care for his dog if he was hospitalized, so I promised I would, and that’s when he gave me the green light to call.”*

It was a good thing, too. At the hospital Ed was diagnosed with a serious blood infection that kept him there for nearly four months. In the meantime, Steve cared for the dog until Ed’s sister arrived from out of town.



**Reflections On the Gospel**

**June 4, 2017**

Sunday's Psalm response is a prayer we may all pray at one time or another, especially when we feel particular desperation as we look around us and see an Earth in pretty bad shape, whether we mean that in terms of the actual state of the physical environment or the conflicts and injustices that seem to plague us. But God has already sent the Spirit, so why are we still praying this prayer? What is it we're longing for that seems to be missing? Could it be that the Spirit is here, but we are the ones missing? The Spirit is God's Power given to us, each in different ways, so that, together, we can combine our gifts to do the very thing for which we are praying: to renew the face of the Earth. And what might that look like? Very likely a place where we have mutual respect for *everyone* without exception, where the needy are cared for, where all enjoy equal opportunities, where all feel safe, where the environment is protected, where we can't miss the Spirit because signs of the Spirit are everywhere in the lives of each of us. Receive the Holy Spirit, and then let's get to work!


