

Pastor's Letter

September 9/10

Gifted and Talented

Dear Parish Family,

About a dozen summers ago I was on a boat ride on Lake George with a group of friends from Long Island. We had a beautiful day of sightseeing and swimming and were heading back across the lake to dock the boat. The afternoon had turned dark and stormy. The wind rose and whipped the lake into waves and whitecaps. The trip home was turning into an uncomfortable adventure. Suddenly we came upon an accident. A small family boat had ventured too close to shore and crashed into rocks. People were injured and in trouble but the wind and waves made it difficult for other boats to get close. Everyone wanted to help. No one really knew how.

Then, one of the men in our boat, a young man named John who was a NYC police officer, tore off his jacket and shoes and jumped into the water. John swam to the victims and kept them afloat and alive until rescue boats with proper equipment arrived. Later that evening I praised him for his courage and for being able to act when everyone else was paralyzed. "There was nothing to think about," he said. "I knew what to do and I had the ability to do it." "Besides," he said, "that could have easily been my family in the water."

Sometimes seeing and understanding our ability and our gifts is the difference between acting and being paralyzed. In our Ministry Fair this weekend we are asking each person to take a look at their gifts and consider using them for the good of our parish. While this may not sound as dramatic as John's act of rescue, it is important to remember that the church of which we are a part grew because men and women placed their various gifts at the service of one another.


I bet you could do it. I bet you could sing in the choir or read the scriptures or serve at the altar. I bet you could bring communion to someone who is homebound. I bet you could join the Knights of Columbus, Legion of Mary, or Adult Faith Formation. I bet you could teach a class in religious education, or help our youth ministry, or usher at Mass. I bet there is something you could do for the good of the life of this parish.

Our Ministry Fair today is an opportunity to see the variety of ministries that are the heart and soul of our parish. It would be so wonderful if every member of our community would have something they do to support our work here at Sacred Hearts. If everyone could say: I know what to do and I have the ability to do it!

The 2017-18 school year will begin on September 6 for the students of OLH. This will mark the beginning of the thirty-fifth anniversary year of the regionalization of the school. Families are invited to explore the options of late enrollment in the East End's premier Catholic elementary school for this year. Limited placement is still available in Kindergarten as well as in grade 4. Admission to the Prep program (grades 6-8) is available after personal interviews and evaluation.



Reflections On the Gospel September 10, 2017



On the eve of the anniversary of September 11th, 2001, Sunday's scripture readings hold particular significance. Both the first reading and the Gospel warn the listeners not to be silent in the face of wrong. The second reading, however, reminds us that whatever we do must be done with love. This goes both ways: If we are the ones to admonish the wrong-doer, we must do it lovingly; if we *are* the wrong-doer, acting in love will help us avoid the wrong in the future. On September 11th, 2001, a grave evil was committed. It would be wrong to deny that, but it is equally wrong to forget the commandment to love in responding to that evil. We are called to speak out against the violence that 9/11/01 perpetuated, the hatred and bigotry, the endless cycle of vengeance and counter-vengeance that bears no good fruit. We are called to model love—of neighbor *and* enemy—to preserve and protect the community that has no outsiders, that is the family of our all-inclusive and loving God. Let it be so.






