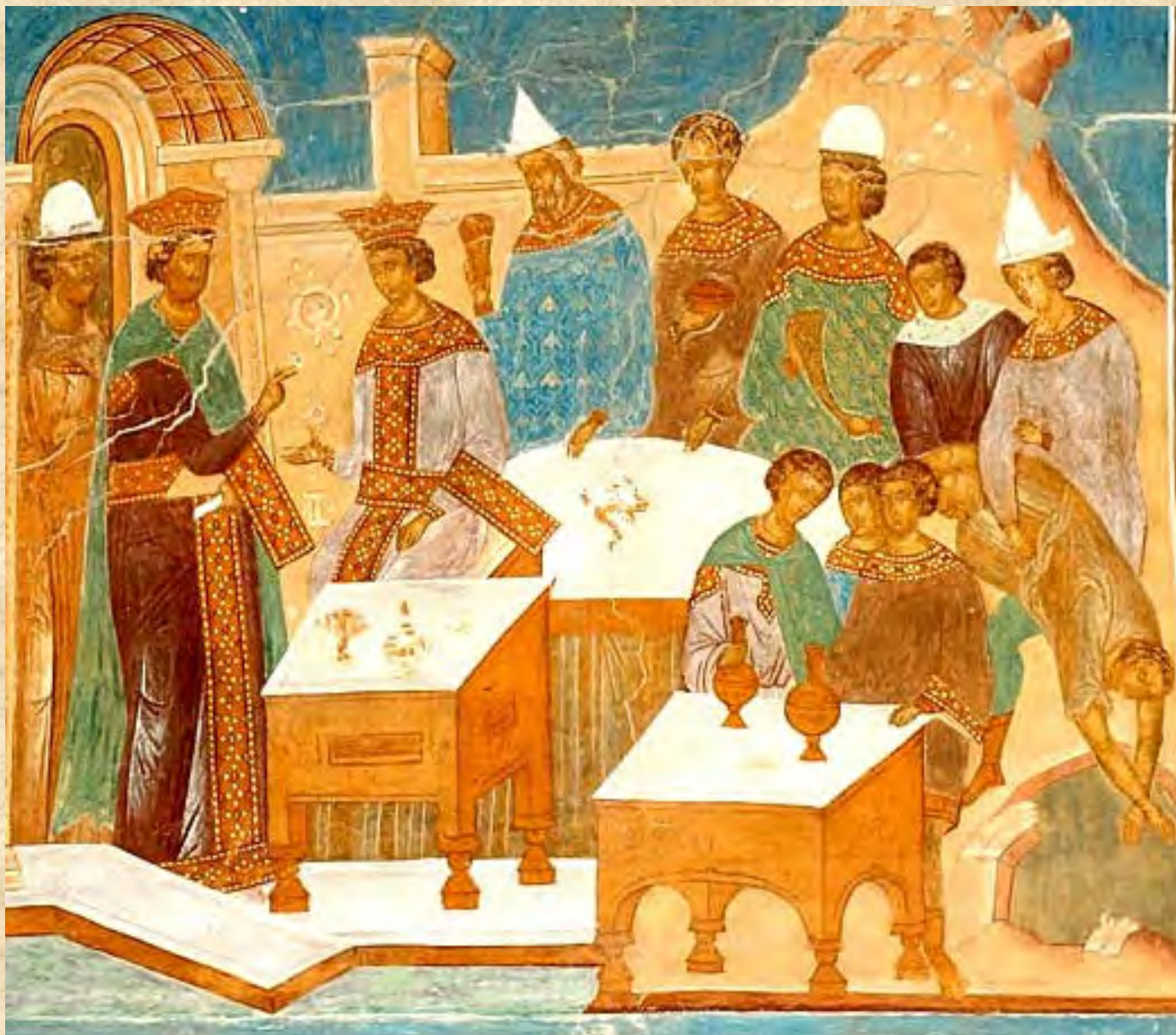

Pastor's Letter

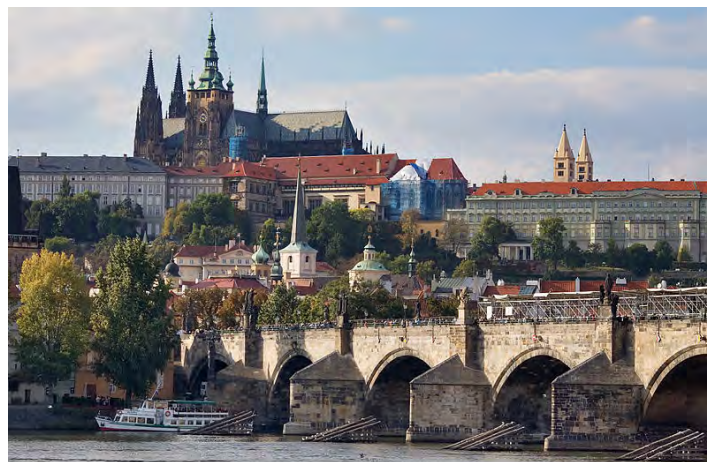
October 21/22

Dear Parish Family,

This spring I will once again offer our parishioners the opportunity to join me on a spiritual pilgrimage. From April 2 to 11, 2018, we will have the opportunity to travel to some of the most beautiful countries in southeastern Europe: Austria, Hungary, and the Czech Republic.

Our journey will take us to some beautiful and historic cities. We will begin in Prague, the capitol of the Czech Republic, a city famous for the preservation of its medieval architecture as well as its special devotion to the childhood of Jesus. Its cathedral is the location of the original statue of the Infant of Prague.

Four Beautiful Cities A Pilgrimage



We will then journey south and west to Salzburg, which is perhaps the quintessential Bavarian city renowned for its baroque architecture. It is one of the best preserved cities north of the Alps. We then travel on to the capital city Vienna with its rich tradition of both faith and music. It is the home of Mozart and is often called the city of music.

Finally our pilgrimage will take us to Budapest, the capital of Hungary. Budapest is an ancient city with roots going back to the Roman Empire. But it is also a modern city, a center of commerce, education, and technology. Its Christian history unfolds around the person of St. Stephen, whose memory as the first Christian martyr is celebrated in the cathedral.

More details will soon be available here in our bulletin and on our website. Our tour host will be 206 Tours. Travel costs begin at \$3799 from JFK with a \$150 discount offered to travelers signing on before November 20th. I look forward to sharing more details with you in the weeks ahead!

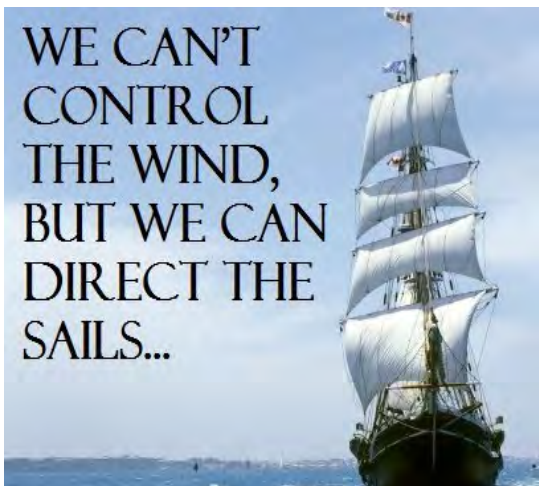

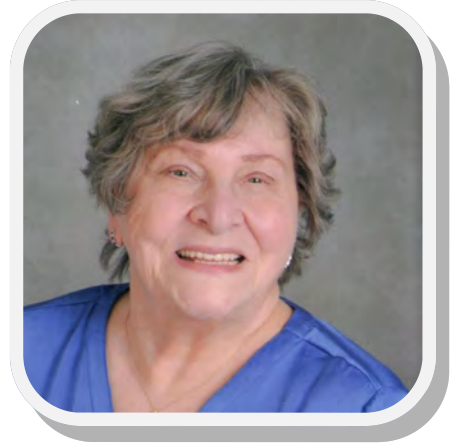

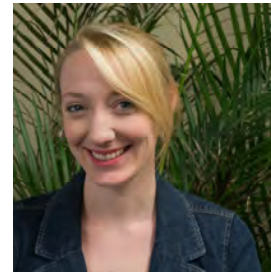

Permisos: Si viven afuera de la zona servida por el Apostolado Hispano, necesitan una carta de su párroco dándonos permiso para bautizar su hijo.

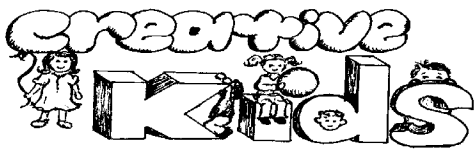

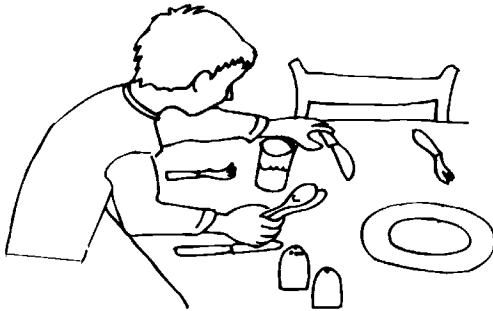


Preparing The Table

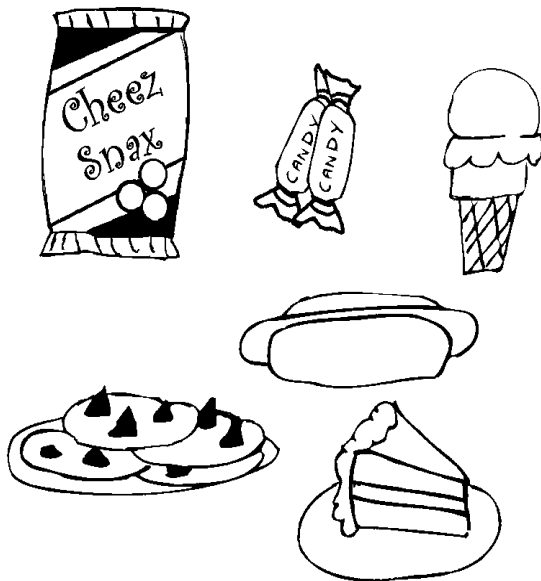

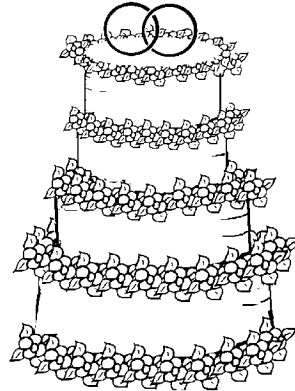
