Pastor's Letter

June 9/10

True to His Call

Dear Parish Family,

The scene in today's gospel is a bit unusual. We see Jesus attacked by his enemies, not on points of teaching or doctrine but on his sanity. Yes, according to Mark's gospel, some of those around Jesus, especially the very proper Scribes and Pharisees, believed he was crazy. To them he seemed like a street corner evangelist shouting a message from a soapbox and disturbing the peace. They were ready to see even his miracles as the magic tricks of a charlatan, or perhaps the work of the devil himself.

It seems that some of this crowd even went to bring Jesus' family to reel him in and take him home. "Your mother and brothers are outside looking for you!" they shout, hoping that his family would quiet him and take him home. The implication, of course, is "Who do you think you are? Remember that you are just the carpenter's son. Now go back where you belong and stop this behavior."

I can relate to this. There have been moments in my growing up where I needed to be reeled in. I can remember friends saying: "I think I hear your parents calling. It's time to go home." But of course there are moments where there is no reeling in. It is time for us to step out on our own. We were not crazy. We were inspired.

People often ask priests and religious about the inspiration behind their vocations. But they don't often ask, "Did anyone think you were crazy?" Believe me, that is a whole other story.

So in the gospel today, after the crowd in effect tells Jesus that he is crazy and that he should go home, Jesus becomes even more resolute. "Whoever does the will of my father in heaven is brother and sister and mother to me!" It is a pivotal point in the gospel. Yes, the carpenter's son is the son of God and he is not letting go of his call because some believe he is crazy.

Christianity requires the willingness to break with the ordinary ways that people see things and act. It requires commitment and passion. Live this way and some will always wonder about your sanity. St. Paul pointed at this when he told his readers that he had become a fool for Christ.

As Jesus was true to his call, be true to your own. Don't let them reel you in.

Reflections On the Gospel
June 10, 2018

Such a tough message in Sunday's Gospel this week! What does it even mean? At least one explanation says that to blaspheme against the Holy Spirit is to deny the work of the Spirit in Jesus and, beyond that, to reject the grace and mercy of the Spirit. Think of Judas who tradition tells us committed suicide in despair for his betrayal of Jesus. So, blaspheming against the Holy Spirit isn't about God withholding forgiveness, but about us refusing forgiveness. Consequently, let us not lose hope. Rather, remember Sunday's responsorial psalm: *With God there is mercy, and fullness of redemption.*

Curso Pre-Bautismal

El curso se da el último domingo de cada mes a la 10:30am en el Apostolado Hispano en Southampton o a las 5:00 PM en la iglesia en East Hampton. Es preciso llevar la copia del acta de nacimiento del niño.

La fecha de los Bautismos:

Los primeros Domingos de mes en Southampton a la 1:30 pm.

Requisitos para el Bautismo de un Niño

Curso: Para bautizar a su hijo, es necesario que los padres y padrinos asistan al curso pre-bautismal. Llevar el acta de nacimiento del niño.

Padrinos: Debe escoger a los padrinos conscientes de los *requisitos*. Los padrinos tienen que ser católicos bautizados, confirmados y que han hecho su Primera Comunión y deben poder comulgar. El padrino (madrina) debe ser un(a) soltero(a) o debe ser casado por la iglesia.
