Pastor's Letter

June 16/17

Summer Projects

Dear Parish Family,

We have just received wonderful news. Our building permit application for our rectory meeting room expansion has been approved by Southampton Village. This means that work can begin soon and hopefully this new space will be ready for the fall. Our rectory and parish office center were originally built as a convent for the sisters serving in Sacred Hearts School. After the parish schools of Sacred Hearts and Our Lady of Poland were merged into Our Lady of the Hamptons Regional School some thirty years ago, the building was reconfigured to become space for parish offices and a residence for our priests. The room we now use for meetings on the first floor was the original convent dining room. It was never intended to hold more than 10-15 people. Since the number of people who often attend hospitality after one of our special Masses or senior luncheons is often twice that size, we really needed a larger space to hold these events.

Over the past months we have examined the options and come up with a plan to build out this dining room and almost double the space. There were many administrative steps along the way as various permits, reviews, and variances were needed. But I am happy to say that this is all behind us now and work on the new space can begin. The project is being financed by a generous grant from the D' Alesandro Foundation and Dreams R Us Foundation, both of which have been great friends to Sacred Hearts. A number of parishioners and organizations such as the Knights of Columbus have also supported our work.

As this new project begins, we are also looking forward to the completion of the walkway on the east side of the basilica. This walkway allows for safe access from church to the rear parking areas. It will also include a new rose garden around our life statue and benches for those who would stop by to say a prayer. The project was supported by a very generous family donation, as well as by our *In Nomine Domini* fund, gifts from the Knights of Columbus, and support from our parishioners. The garden benches will be provided in memory of Ellie Finalborgo. Lighting was provided by Eldor and the landscaping work and brickwork donated in part by Marcus Stinchi and Edward Corrigan.

We are hoping to continue improving the walkways along the church and are also working on plans for the plaza in front of the church.

Stay tuned for updates as the work progresses.

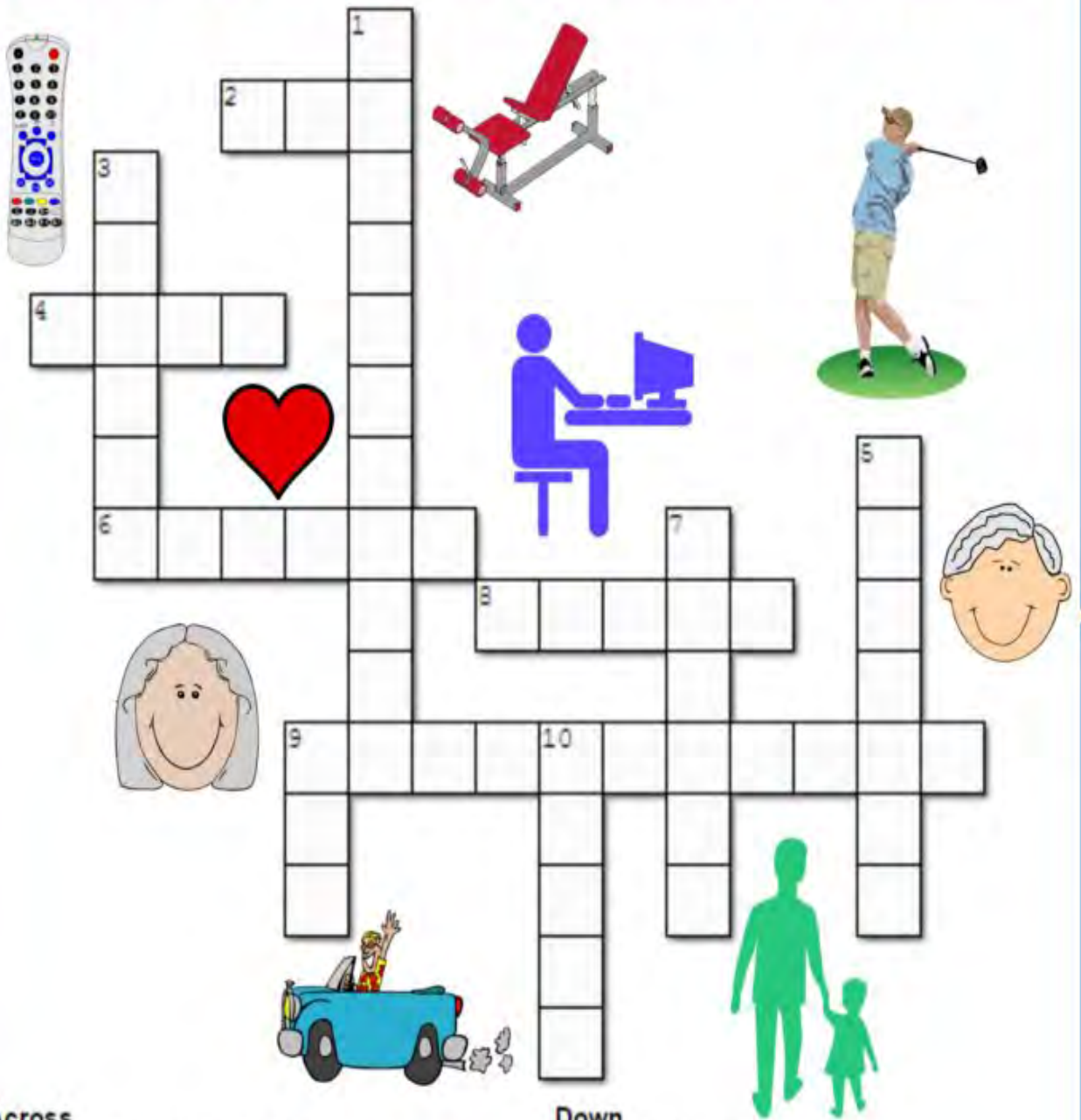
