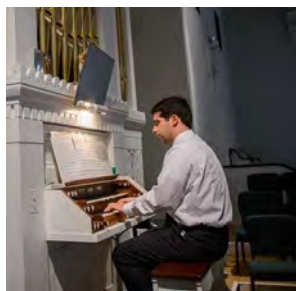

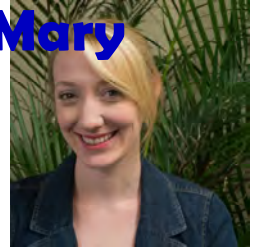

- ◆ time to teach for an hour on Sundays (10:30-11:30) or on Wednesdays (4:00-5:00 for grades 1-6 and 7:00-8:00 for grades 7 and 8) plus time to prepare lessons and to set up for a few minutes before each class
- ◆ time to attend teacher meeting every 4-6 weeks

What we will give you:

- ◆ an outline of what your students need to learn during the year
- ◆ student materials—textbooks and periodicals, and teacher guides
- ◆ support and information at teacher meetings, when we discuss what to teach and how to teach it well

What you will receive:

- ◆ the satisfaction of passing on the Faith, as generations have done for us
- ◆ the opportunity to work with other wonderful catechists
- ◆ enrichment of your own Faith. The way to really know and understand something is to teach it. The questions your students ask and the questions that come to your own mind bring you to a deeper, more profound life of faith.

Reflections On the Gospel
August 26, 2018

Sunday's Gospel seems to begin in the middle of a conversation, and, indeed, it does. The disciples are quoted, "This saying is hard." What saying? We have to remember last Sunday's Gospel when Jesus declared that he is the living bread to be consumed for eternal life. Is it any wonder that some people chose to leave him? To make matters worse, Jesus adds: "What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before?"

Could it be that Jesus was purposely presenting his followers with the truth of the challenges of the faith? Could it be that he wanted them to choose knowingly and freely? There is little doubt Jesus wanted people to believe and to serve and be served, but it is equally certain he wanted them to do so willingly. We, too, must recognize that faith can be hard, that Jesus invites us into it, but he does not force us to accept it. To whom shall you go?
