New Life! At Easter We Celebrate Jesus' Resurrection

1. Read John 20:11:18 from your Bible at home. Or, you can google “John 20:11-18” and read that passage from the Gospel of St. John in the New Testament. What happened to Mary of Magdala in those lines? How do you think that experience changed her?

2. What is an experience of new life that is around you? What symbolizes hope and newness for you? Take a picture of something that represents new life to you. Put the picture in the space below on the right. Then explain why that picture is significant to you.

3. Ask an adult to tell you about something that is new life and hope for them and to write about it. Who did you ask?

4. At the end of religious education class, you received a packet with soil and seeds. Plant the seeds right away according to the directions. Take good care of your plant! Right before you come back to religious education class in May, take a picture of your plant so we can see how it grew. If your plant did not grow or did not grow well, try to figure out what would have helped that plant to grow. Tell your religious education class why you think your plant did or did not grow. What do you need in order to grow right now?
