Signs of Belonging and Love

Baptism is a sacrament. It is a sign that we belong to God and we are part of the Catholic community of faith. With an adult, watch the 5:52 minute Baptism – Flame of Love video of some children being baptized at https://brisbanecatholic.org.au/articles/catholic-baptism/. In the video, you saw the parent or godparent holding the baby and the priest pouring water over baby's head.


Draw a picture of the priest baptizing the baby.

What is your baptismal name?
Where were you baptized?
Who are your godparents?

There are many ways we experience God's love for us. Some people show us that love in special ways. St. Valentine was a priest who lived many years ago. His special job as God's helper was to marry the men and women who wanted to get married. That's why he is the patron saint of love and marriage. His feast day is February 14, which we call St. Valentine's Day.
