The Rosary

We connect with all the people who are important to us. We talk to them, call them, text them, and use a wide variety of social media sites to learn about them and tell them about ourselves. We connect with significant people in many ways.

The most important relationship in our lives is our relationship with God. We connect with God in many ways. We call this connection “prayer.” Read about three ways to pray on page 43 in your Venture Handbook, which you received in your folder on the first day of class. Also read about how to pray the Rosary, on page 54. These pages were emailed to your parents with this activity.



Some people adapt that prayer and say a Gratitude Rosary. The purpose is to say “Thank you God” for everything you can possibly think of. Start with the Sign of the Cross. Then Our Father. Pray 3 Hail Mary’s on the next 3 beads and Glory Be to the Father. Then replace each Hail Mary bead saying what you want to thank God for. You will come up with 50 things you are thankful for. Giving thanks to God is powerful! End by making the Sign of the Cross.

For this activity, read the pages 43 and 54 in your Venture Handbook. Then pray the rosary with someone or several people in your home. You can pray the traditional rosary or a gratitude rosary. If you don’t have rosary beads in your house, email reled@shjmbasilica.org and we will get them to you.
