Pope Francis says, “We are frequently tempted to think that holiness is only for those who can withdraw from ordinary affairs to spend much time in prayer. That is not the case. We are all called to be holy by living our lives with love and by bearing witness in everything we do, wherever we find ourselves.”

We remember the saints because they can show us ways and encourage us to live our lives with love. Choose one saint or holy person. How did s/he live their life with love? As you think about that saint’s life, what is one way you can follow their example and live your life with love? You may want to google the lives of some saints to find out information you didn’t know before.

Suggestion: Four American churchwomen were martyred in El Salvador in 1980 because of their work with the poor. They have not yet been declared saints, but they certainly lived their lives with love. Archbishop Oscar Romero was also martyred in 1980 for standing up for the rights of the poor. He has been declared a saint. You may want to learn about the churchwomen or Archbishop Romero for this activity.

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2. Talk with your parents or any adult. Ask them to choose a saint and tell you how the saint lived their life with love. Ask the adult how they try to live their life with love, as that saint did.

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
